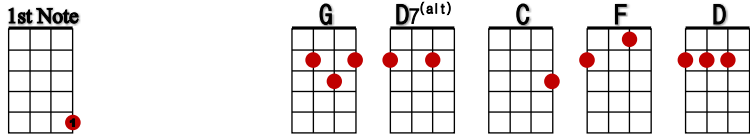


# Oh, What A Beautiful Mornin'
